Questions & Answers

Where is it ?

The contest and the courses will take place in Parc de la Dodaine, Nivelles - BELGIUM.

How to you get there ?

By train : 30min from Bruxelles center / 1h from Bruxelles Airport Zaventem
There is a parking available on location if you come by car.

What do you need ?

Take your favourite bow and some arrows (all the same). Take your good mood, best smile and leave at home your ego and stress. The tournament is above all a way to meet each other and spend good time together. Food and drinks will be available on location.

How to you register, how much is it ?

Are you good enough in Asiatic Archery ?

As long as you know how to shoot with thumbrelease and if you reach a target at 18m, it's ok for us. The important thing is to be concentrated and not stressed. The skills we'll ask for the shootings are : precision, shooting in movement, speed shooting. All target distances will be unknown. Performance is not that important. Consistency, robustness, happiness are far better.

What about Armin Hirmer ?

Armin Hirmer is our godfather for the event and Asiatic Archery Belgium. He will be the master judge of the contest and will lead the event. Thanks to him !
